

A Resolution to the Synod of South Atlantic
at its 15th Stated Meeting
at Agnes Scott College, Decatur, Georgia
June 8, 2007

Whereas the PC(U.S.A.) promotes justice for workers throughout the world; and

Whereas our church is a leader in promoting education, particularly higher education; and

Whereas we have been given the hospitality of the staff and faculty of Agnes Scott College and the wonderful resources maintained by the hourly wage earners of Agnes Scott College; and

Whereas the maintenance hourly wage earners are striving to obtain a living wage for all employees of Agnes Scott College and are supported by President Kiss, but find the goal still elusive;

Now therefore be it Resolved by the Synod of South Atlantic that it commends the Board of Trustees of Agnes Scott College in its positive approach to establish a living wage for all employees of Agnes Scott College, and the Synod commends the Board to approach its decisions in the Spirit of the Word of Jesus Christ.
